What You Need to Know

▶ **Not Hypermobility EDS:** Crucial to distinguish—mistakes can be life-threatening.

▶ **Characteristics of VEDS: Physical Features:** Thin skin, visible veins, thin nose, thin upper lip, large/deep-set eyes.

Family History: VEDS or arterial/intestinal ruptures.

▶ **Emergency Situations:** Arterial Dissection, Arterial Rupture, Pneumothorax, Carotid Cavernous Sinus Fistula, Bowel Perforation
